What is Journal TOCs?

Journal TOCs is a free online resource which allows you to keep up to date with all of your favourite journals from a choice of thousands that are published.



How to search

- Go to www.journaltocs.hw.ac.uk
- Click on the "sign up" link in the centre of the page for your free account.

To start a search for a journal, type the journal title in the white search box on the left hand side of the screen

- Select the journal you want from the list below the search box to view the journal's TOC.
- To view the article abstract click on the article title in the centre of the screen and you will be taken to the publisher website.
- If you want to follow a journal, tick the box that says "follow" next to the journal name and it will automatically be added to your "followed journals" list

How to create email alerts

- To activate the email alerts hover the pointer over your name on the top right hand side of the screen and select "followed journals".
 You will then see a list of the journals you are following.
 Below the list, tick the box to turn email alerts on.
- You can also search for articles on a specific topic by typing the subject in the white search box on the home page and selecting "for articles by keyword" just below this search box.

You can also search by publisher

NB: Journal TOCs will only show the most current TOC for the journal and will not archive older TOCs.
