# Getting here

Welcome to Royal Papworth Hospital.

This leaflet gives you some information about how to get to the hospital, which is located on the Cambridge Biomedical Campus.



## Travelling by car

If you are travelling by car, you can:

### **Park at Trumpington Park & Ride, Hauxton Road, CB2 9FT.**

Then take busway route A or D to the hospital's north entrance. This is a five-minute bus journey.

### **Park at Babraham Road Park & Ride, Babraham Road, CB22 3AB.**

Then take the bus to Addenbrooke's Hospital bus stop. It is then a 15-minute walk to Royal Papworth Hospital.

### **Drive to the site and park in Car Park 2, CB2 0AY.**

Patients are entitled to discounted rates, but you will need to show your appointment letter or card at the customer service desk within the car park for the rate to be applied. Other rates, including discounted weekly tickets, apply for visitors.

There is also a drop-off point outside the hospital itself (postcode CB2 0AY) with a maximum 30-minute stay. Disabled spaces are available outside the hospital (with a maximum four-hour stay), or in Car Park 2.

## Travelling by public transport

To find a suitable bus route, please visit [www.google.com/maps](http://www.google.com/maps), type in 'CB2 0AY' and select 'directions'.

If you enter your home postcode you will be shown a selection of bus routes. The Stagecoach bus app can also help you plan your route and contains real-time bus information.

Cambridge is the nearest train station. From there, you can take a bus to the Cambridge Biomedical Campus, or take a taxi from the train station to the hospital (approximately 10-15 minutes).
