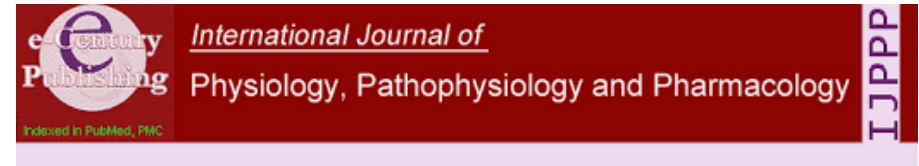

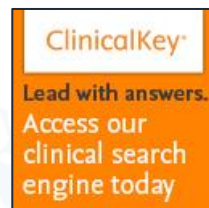

## Databases

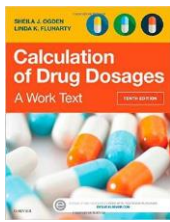
