

## EBSCO Quick Access Guide


E-books available to Royal Papworth staff on EBSCO can be accessed directly from the book record in the ELMS catalogue. The URL for the catalogue is:

Please note that you need to have an OpenAthens account to access EBSCO. If you don't have one, you can register here <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/>


### To access:
