Audiobooks for patients

Occupational Therapy said: 'Do we have any audiobooks for patients? I think they would be of benefit.'



We did: A literature search to see if there's evidence of the therapeutic benefit of audiobooks for recovery. We ran a focus group with patients to find out their views. We investigated the feasibility of a digital platform for loaning audiobooks to patients and found that it was much too expensive. So we contacted our colleagues at Cambridgeshire Libraries and they gave us 7 Kindles devices on long term loan and access to 5000+ audiobook titles for free. Royal Papworth Hospital Charity kindly funded cases for the devices.


Where are we now?

- 2. **Drugs & Drug Interactions** you can quickly check for possible drug-to-drug and drug-to-herb interactions with the UpToDate drug interactions tool.
- 3. **Graphics Search** this powerful search engine feature allows you to search over 10,000 pictures, charts, movies and illustrations.
- 4. **Patient Education** UpToDate includes more than 1,500 patient information topics. You can review this information with patients in the exam room, print out as handouts, or send via email.
- 5. **Practice Changing UpDates** UpToDate will notify you when a topic you have previously read has been impacted by a Practice Changing update.
